CE MARKING OF ANCHOR PLATES

CE marking means that a product is produced and controlled in accordance with a harmonized European standard (hEN) or a European Technical Assessment (ETA). ETA can be used as basis for CE marking in cases where no harmonized EN standard is available.

In case of anchor plates there is no applicable harmonized standard available. However, some manufacturers have CE-marked their anchor plates based on EN 1090-1.

According to a list provided by the European Committee of Standardization (CEN), which is downloadable on the European Commission's website at <http://ec.europa.eu/DocsRoom/documents/5744/attachments/1/translations/>, anchor plates are not covered by EN 1090-1. Therefore, EN 1090-1 cannot be used as basis for the CE marking of anchor plates. This is also confirmed on page 6 of EAD 330084-00-0601 dd. 1/2016 Steel plate with cast-in anchors: "The product is not covered by a harmonised European standard (hEN)."

Therefore, currently the only way to CE-mark anchor plates is through obtaining an ETA for the product and after that applying for CE marking.
